Professor Dominique Charron was born in Nantes France. He joined the Nantes'medical school & the Paris Intern/Residency program in Hematology at Hospital Saint-Louis with Prof. Jean Bernard .He further trained as a Post-Doctoral fellow with Pr. Hugh O McDevitt and research Assistant Professor at Stanford University in the Department of Immunology & Microbiology. Trained as an Immunologist, he specialized in HLA and Molecular Immunogenetics, Transplantation & Regenerative Medicine, basic and

Currently, he is Professor Emeritus of Medicine at Paris University, Medical Advisor for international biology at the international affairs department of the Greater Paris University Hospital (AP-HP) General Directorate.

He was appointed in 2016 Consulting Professor at Jiaotong University/Ruijing Hospital in Shanghai -China & Professor at Unistra (University of Strasbourg-France). He is an SAB member of the Chinese society of Blood Transfusion since 2013.

He is the Editor in Chief of the international journal "Exploration of Immunology".

Founding President of HLA-MED (HLA & Medicine) He is the co-Founder and CMO of Asfalia Biologics. Formerly, Pr. Charron founded with and headed the "Jean Dausset" (Nobel Prize in Medicine 1980) Histocompatibility & Immunogenetics laboratory (largest HI Laboratory Worldwide) at Hospital Saint-Louis and the immunology specialized INSERM research units U396, U662 & U940. He authorly contributed to over 500 papers in high-ranking journals (Nature, Cell, NEJM, J.Exp.Med, Blood, PNAS, Lancet, J of Immunology, Human Immunology ...etc.) in the fields of immunology, immunogenetics, transplantation, autoimmunity & regenerative medicine.

He organized and chaired the 12th International Histocompatibility Workshop and Conference (12th IHWC), acted as President of the International Histocompatibility Council (HIC) and of the European Federation of Immunogenetics (EFI), and contributed as founding member to the creation of the Laboratory of Excellence Transplanted.

Prof. Charron has been an invited speaker at over 250 international conferences and Academic organizations worldwide. He is the Honorary President of the Franco Egyptian Immunology Conferences of immunology and of the Pujiang Transplantation Immunology Symposium in Shanghai. Prof. Charon's accomplishments were aknowledged by many rewards including the Bernard Halpern Immunology Prize, the Ruggerro Ceppellini Lecture & Award of the EFI, the Claude Bernard Grand Prize in Medicine & the Rose Payne Award of the ASHI (American Society of Histocompatibility & Immunogenetics) in 2017.
